Philippe Boisseau is a member of the Executive Committee at Total, the world's fourth-ranked international oil company. As President of the Marketing & Services, he is in charge of the business division that supplies and markets petroleum products and provides associated services. He also heads the New Energies Division and has expanded its activities significantly since the 2011 takeover of SunPower, the world No. 2 in solar energy. Mr. Boisseau joined Total in 1995 and has held a number of positions internationally, along the way acquiring broad knowledge of the entire oil and gas value chain and of the energy industry in general. He is an alumni of France's Ecole Polytechnique engineering school and a member of France's engineering Corps des Mines.



Dr. Markus Tacke

Siemens CEO Windpower and Renewables

Mr. Tacke presides the "Siemens Division Windpower and Renewables", which is the world's number one offshore manufacturer. He serves as Chairman of the "European Wind Energy Association", and therefore, he is ranked 3rd among the top 30 most influential wind industry leaders by the journal "Windpower Monthly". Before moving into the wind sector, he led the fossil-fuel driven steam and gas turbine business unit.



Ulrike Andres

President & CEO TAL Transalpine Pipeline

Mrs. Andres, born in Vienna, is an experienced manager in the energy, oil and gas industry. She is head of the TAL Group, which conducts the Transalpine Pipeline. This is the only crude oil pipeline supplying the refineries in southern Germany, Austria and partially the Czech Republic, by starting from the marine terminal in Trieste. Previously, Mrs. Andres held various positions at Shell International and the Dutch trading company SHV Group.



Thomas Raffener

Founder & CEO The Mobility House

Mr. Raffener founded The Mobility House in 2009, being a pioneer in the E-Mobility-Scene. He created a service company providing charging and energy solutions for leading car manufacturers, such as TESLA and BMW. TMH has since become the only national and neutral provider of charging stations, installation services and energy solutions for e-mobility in Europe. He is convinced that the end of the age of fossil fuel is coming closer.
